Goals

Requirements & Procedures

1. Individually you must develop your own myth and then create an illustrated children's book that tells the story of your myth.
2. Your myth must meet the definition of a myth that we developed together as a class. It also must include some of the elements of a myth as defined by Ferguson in pages 6-15 of her Introduction.
3. Your book must be at least eight pages long, not including cover/title pages. There must be text and image on each page.
