



Roman Object Project

Goal: To recreate some object that Romans would have used in daily life, to research the materials from which it would have been made and the use to which it would have been put.

Step I: Select object.

Step II: Research appearance and materials of object. Use both online and written sources.

Step III: Come up with a plan to recreate object using inexpensive materials. I would love to see life-sized replicas, but if the object you choose is very large, a model is acceptable.

Step IV: Make the object.

Some Possible Roman Objects

- ✓ coins, bulla, strigil, sandals, lamp, wax tablet, parchment scroll and pen, groma, toga, wig, jewelry, makeup, plow, urn, shield, sword, tomb
- ✓ If two or three students would like to work together on a model of a Roman building, such as a temple, villa, insula, or bathhouse, this would also work well.
