Nota Bene: World cultures often have numerous deities presiding over different aspects of the same domain. For example, in the Mayan culture, Chak is the god of rain who is therefore responsible for the growth of crops, while Hun Hunahpu has equal importance as the god of the Mayans' most important crop, maize. The chart above generally only lists one or two more important deities out of the many that often exist for each domain in each culture.
